Alex Harvey is Canada's most decorated cross-country skier, earning 30 World Cup podiums and five (5) World Championship podiums before retiring in 2019, a competitive record of undisputed national and international significance. Recognized with the Meritorious Service Cross by the Governor General of Canada, his athletic legacy stands on its own. What elevates his candidacy further is the depth and continuity of his post-career leadership. Since 2018 he has served as spokesperson for both Accès Psy, which removes financial barriers to psychological care, and Le Diplôme avant la Médaille, which uses sport to keep at-risk youth in school. He served as an Administrator at the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada from 2019 to 2023, protecting athletes at a national institutional level. He is also President of the Cercle des Gouverneur's du Bal du Maire de Québec and is involved with the Fondation Jeunes En Tête. Throughout his career, Harvey was the public face of cross-country skiing in Quebec, inspiring a generation of young athletes. Nominated by the former Chair of Nordiq Canada and supported by the President of Ski de Fond Québec, he represents both competitive excellence and enduring contribution to snow sports and Canadian society.
